- The November minutes were approved.
- Priorities on the athletics wish list are: wrestling mats, volleyball titanium poles \$4,000, baseball Rhapsodo machine \$4,500, smart speed gate for Track and Field \$2,500, Lacrosse Goals \$1,800. Swimming touch pads that cost \$2,312 were already purchase in the Fall. Items outside of the Wrestling mats were approved for purchase by a unanimous vote.

Athletic Director

- The return of Students and Teachers to in-person attended at GBN is imminent.
- Roughly 75% to 80% of our teachers will be teaching in person. The rest will remain teaching remotely via Zoom.
- About 35% or roughly 700 or so kids are returning to GBN. School will be full day at this point for any student that want to attend in person. Students attending in person school or extracurricular activities will be asked to submit a non-diagnostic saliva test weekly. If the test is not submitted, student will not be allowed to attend in person activities or school on campus until the saliva sample is submitted the following week.
- A pilot of group athletes has already been submitting a non-diagnostic saliva test 2 times a week. Since the pilot started, we have had 3 people who have come back as inconclusive. All 3 of these individuals did come back with a diagnostic PCR test as positive for Covid-19.
- The IDPH and IHSA met last week and no dates were set for a return to sports and no plans came from the meeting. All sports continue to be on pause. IHSA met again today, but no start dates have been set. As soon as the Governor's office allows low risk sports to start, the IHSA will start the season.
- February 18th will be Athletics and Activity night for 8th graders. It will be different than in the past due to the 50 person restrictions per rooms. The evening will be handled via Zoom.
- We lost a football player recently to depression and we are working to support our students in their grief. GBN is running several programs in an effort to support our kids. Other community groups have also stepped up to offer programs to support our students, as well.
- May 22 is when Spring Sports night has been scheduled. Senior Banquet is currently scheduled for May 25th and May 27th is when Senior night is scheduled.
