• The January minutes were approved.

• We will be creating spirit bags for the Winter athletes similar to what the Booster Club did for Fall athletes. There are about 300 Winter athletes.

- We have received about \$9500 in honor of Dylan Buckner. We are holding this money while we work with his family to decide how best to use it.
- We discussed a few ideas for Booster Bash. The current Covid situation is still in flux and it was decided to hold off having discussions on it until we can decide if it is safe to hold an event.

Athletic Director

- The athletic training room is being renovated currently by D225. We would like the Booster Club to fund 4 new tables. They are putting in a new floor they have painted it and gotten new cabinets, countertops and lighting. It was a project that needed to be done and will benefit all GBN sports teams.
- The scheduling has been an on and off scramble with teams quarantining. We try to find games to play when one is cancelled. Coaches from all over our area are working together to make sure kids get playing time.
- All home games are currently ticketed events to control the number of individuals in the gym. The gym is sanitized between each game if the games follow each other.
- The new scoreboard has been in action over the weekend. It looks great and it has been a nice addition.
- Multisport athletes and Coaches who overlap 2 sports is a concern for the upcoming Spring and Summer seasons. The head coaches have been holding multiple meetings to put agreements in to place to reduce conflicts so the kids don't have to decide which practice or game to attend if they are part of a sport in both seasons. Our goal is not to make the kids feel like they are stuck in the middle or that they have to choose. GBN has 14 coaches that are in an overlap situation with the 2 seasons. They have also waived the need to have 7 practices to start a new season, except for Football. That requirement is still in effect for football.
- We are conducting weekly saliva Covid tests. 913 students are here at GBN in person for some activity, school or an athletic event. They must submit their saliva sample on Tuesday or Wednesday each week. There is a hard deadline of 3:30 on Wednesday afternoon to submit the samples. We are catching a handful of kids who are identified as undefined results. We have one team guarantined right now for having a student who was with the team that tested positive.

- Many of the teachers and coaches have had their first Covid vaccine shot. The GBN Nurses and Athletic Trainers have mostly had both.
- We are trying to broadcast games and events. We are on hold with Hudl Focus Camera waiting
 for a part but will start streaming with that service as soon as possible. Currently those events
 that are being streamed are being stream on YouTube and links are being sent out prior to events
 so parents can watch.

Treasurer

- We have \$88,200 in our bank local account. Some of it is being held for a Dylan Buckner memorial There is \$70,074.60 in the GBN held funds.
- Articles of incorporations have been filed in preparation for filing for the 501(c)3.
