- We are still working on 2 positions on the executive board, a Booster Bash Rep and Concessions Rep.
- Erin and Garry provided a wish list of Booster Club Projects for 2022-2023. A motion was made and approved unanimously to pay for all of the items requested, for. A total of \$31,645.00 has been committed for those projects.
- Emily Taylor is joining the board to take on the Membership Chair role.
- We discussed the impacts that the pandemic and how it has forced changes to the athletic programs. We all agreed that even though the team all-level mandatory pizza parties had gone by the wayside during the pandemic, it is important that they return. To promote team bonding, get the athletes excited about the programs, help the reps to collect for Coaches gifts and ensure important information is relayed to athletes and parents directly from the Coaches.
- We discussed creating a pool of general volunteers we can reach out to for special projects.

Athletic Director

- We ended last week with all the teams, 3 conference championships, 3 sectional championships, one regional championship. We had a number of successful Spring athletic seasons and are proud of our athletes.
- Summer Athletic Camps have started in several sports and will continue to run throughout the summer. We have hundreds of current athletes and youth athletes arriving on campus this summer for camps in many sports. It looks to be a busy summer and returning to pre-covid level of participation in summer camp sessions.
- We have limited coach openings and low turnover so far for next year.
- The two issues coming up we'd like to consider is the Softball scoreboard, Softball batting cages and stadium renovations. As far as the Football/Lacrosse/Soccer stadium, the district is looking at new lights, new bleachers and even a new entrance way is being considered with revamped styling and improved fence location and stadium access.
- Summer school is starting next week. GBN is undertaking a huge remodeling project with 70 classrooms being renovated, so a lot of construction will be going on this summer.
- Regularly schedule contract negotiations are set to open up between teachers and coaches and district D225 and will cover both GBS and GBN employees.

Treasurer

- Cari provided us a Booster Club Profit and Loss statement. The Booster Club made roughly \$77,800 this year.

- We have roughly \$230,000 in the bank.
