#### Athletic Director

- This season has been incredibly difficult as far as scheduling for the sports playoffs.
- Youth and high school summer camps have started and are going smoothly.

#### Treasurer

- GBN Booster Club has roughly \$68,000 in our bank local account. Roughly \$12,000 of it is being held for a Dylan Buckner memorial. There is roughly \$72,000 in the GBN held funds.
- Cari has received invoices for the plaques given by booster for athletes in 3 sports and 12 sports and athletics MVP's.
