- There was discussion around which people working the home games get a free meal. Referees for the football team are given a meal. Some coaches do also.

#### Athletic Director

- All of the athletics are running very smoothly other than terrible bus service. We are struggling to get people places on time. We've been pushing start times back for events, using the mini buses, doing everything we can to get the kids to the places they are supposed to be.
- Tryout numbers are healthy. We have lots of kids competing in many of our sports.

- We have some spring coach openings. It has been challenging to find people to fill those spots.
- We are still spending a lot of time on covid testing. We have a drop test tomorrow. Starting next week we have to pull kids out of athletics if they don't submit a test.
- Last week we had zero positive covid tests for students and faculty.

#### **Treasurer**

- The 501(c)3 paperwork has been approved. Yay!
- We would like to transfer money from the GBN account to our regular account. GBN is holding \$106,000 of the Booster Club's money.
- Our regular account at NB Bank has \$74,000, roughly \$12K is being held for a Dylan Buckner memorial.

- Completed an email campaign for Cathy to encourage Booster Membership and to come up to the next home game and pick up their membership materials.
