Athletic Director

- Juliet Frum was all state as a Freshman in Girls Cross Country and set a school record for the 3mile distance.
- The Girl's Tennis team won their sectional match.
- Boys and Girls golf had an amazing season. With the boys winning state as a team and with Jason Gordon winning state as an individual. The Girls Golf Team had their best ever finish this year, as well.
- We have seen healthy participant numbers for all winter sports teams. Teams are being formed right now, unfortunately some teams will have to cut kids. If kids don't make a team, there are other winter options like swimming and wrestling.
- Competition in the Central Suburban League is almost back to normal, outside of wearing masks.
 Some small changes like no food in the GBN Gym will remain. Showers and locker rooms are back to normal use.
- The covid shield testing after Halloween resulted in 23 positive cases in D225. In addition, there were some close contacts.
- We are doing another test after Thanksgiving and there may be more whole school testing after that.
- We are having a Thanksgiving week basketball tournament. The schedule has already come out.
 We will be looking for help staffing the concession stand during the tournament.
- Official enrollment at GBN is 1987 students, the smallest school in the CSL conference.
- In coaching news: We are actively searching for a head Boys Water Polo coach for this Spring. Paul Vignocchi has stepped down as the Boys Varsity Soccer coach. John will be starting a search for a replacement coach for that spot. There likely will be several coach openings over the next few seasons.

- Our regular account at NB Bank has \$203,340 between, roughly \$12K is being held for a Dylan Buckner memorial.
